## An attorney with bite

His clients know him as Mad Dog. And it's quite a list of clients: singer Willie Nelson, actor Matthew McConaughey, a Branch Davidian survivor. Joe Turner, a one-time prison guard who argued his way into law school, may not seek the spotlight, but it keeps finding him nevertheless. Turner, who started his career as a prosecutor earning less than \$15,000 a year, tries to outwork opposing attorneys while making the case that his client isn't so different from those sitting in the jury box. "My job is getting jurors to understand the case from the perspective of the accused. Get them thinking, 'You know, that could happen to me,' "he says.
